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MANY RIVERS MONTESSORI ANNOUNCES WENDY REINSCH FISHER AS NEW HEAD OF SCHOOL

Fisher comes to Duluth and Many Rivers as a lifelong Montessori educator, leader, parent, and advocate. "I believe that Montessori pedagogy offers an elegant and coherent means for delivering an evidence-based education," said Fisher. "Many Rivers Montessori's commitment to authentic Montessori truly resonates with me. The educators here have created a warm, inviting and well-prepared learning environment. I am honored to work to further Many Rivers' exciting and impactful educational mission."

Fisher was Head of School at Mountaintop Montessori in Charlottesville, Virginia, a Montessori independent school, from 2004–2016. Other Montessori leadership roles include Managing Director of Great River School in St. Paul, Vice President of Education for LePort Schools, and Administrator Course Coordinator for Baishan Montessori Teacher Education Institute. She has also served on the board of the Virginia Association of Independent Schools.

Fisher holds Association Montessori Internationale (AMI) certifications at the Primary (preschool–Kindergarten) and Elementary (1st through 6th Grade) levels, as well as North American Montessori Teachers Association Adolescent (7th through 12th Grade) certification. She taught Montessori students at all three levels prior to becoming Head of School at Mountaintop Montessori.

Following her keen interest in Montessori pedagogy, Fisher has worked on research studies with noted Montessori researcher Angeline Lillard at the University of Virginia, and subsequently

completed her doctoral coursework in Educational Leadership at the same institution. She holds a Masters of Education from Loyola University of Maryland, a Bachelor of Science in Journalism from University of Maryland College Park, and a certification in Charter School Leadership from Southwest Minnesota State University.
